We would not be here without the generous support of you and those individuals, various businesses and philanthropic institutions who made a commitment to our capital campaign, *Building Our Future. Honoring Our Tradition*. We also would not be here without the commitment of those who have gone before and continue to support our mission through planned gifts. It is through both planned gifts and the capital campaign that we were able to bring required equity to this construction project and also support ourselves during the time of reduced occupancy.


